2	<b>M/s. Trident College of Marine Technology (MTI No.312020) Kolkata</b>	Due to the lack of shipboard training and placement opportunities, the board discussed reducing batch sizes. It was agreed to recommend the removal of one batches annually and monitor the institute's performance with reduced intake.  <b>Decision:</b> The decision of the PO, MMD Kolkata was accepted
3	<b>Irregularities and Alleged Unauthorized Activities Associated with Girik Institute of Maritime Studies and M/s. Grik Maritime Academy (MTI No. 208073)</b>	<b>Decision:</b> This agenda was deferred to next meeting
4	<b>Irregularities and Alleged Unauthorized Activities Associated with SCMS NADHAL MTI and SCMS Marine Training Centre (MTI No. 204075)</b>	<b>Decision:</b> This agenda was deferred to next meeting
5	<b>Matter of M/s. C.V. Raman College of Engineering, Odisha (MTI No. 302004).</b>	A surprise inspection was conducted of MTI (CIP Grading - C2), revealing poor infrastructure, non-functional facilities, untrained staff, and safety violations.  <b>Decision:</b> The decision of the PO, MMD Kolkata was accepted
6	<b>M/s. Pondicherry Maritime Academy, PUDUCHERRY [Application No. 100803, 100802, 100801, 100809]</b>	MMD Chennai recommended approving the courses only with reduced batch sizes and frequencies across all courses.  <b>Decision:</b> The decision of the PO, MMD Chennai was accepted

7	<b>Presentation on pendency of online in-principle approval and course approval of MTIs.</b>	DDG Trg. gave presentation on the pending applications. Jurisdictional POs submitted the updates/status.
8	<b>Review of legal matters in Training Division – updates thereof.</b>	Legal Consultant (Trg.) informed the board that the number of active cases with the training branch has decreased from 14 to 13.
9	<b>Confirmation of publication of results at every STCW compliance Board meeting:</b>	Dy.CS updated that all results for August from the engineering stream have been declared as per the prescribed timeline, fulfilling the requirement for result publication.
10	<b>Recognition of Open School Board Certificates in Maritime Training Eligibility</b>	DDG Trg. informed the board that the Office will continue recognizing NIOS certificates for maritime training and education. Whereas, State open school boards shall not be accepted, and a reply will be sent to IMU confirming this stance, with no changes to the current policy.
11	<b>Request for extension period for Construction of Swimming Pool and Waterbody w.r.t DGS Training Circular No. 06 of 2025.</b>	MMD Mumbai gave the presentation of eight extension requests, only two were recommended for limited extension, while others were advised to suspend relevant courses until compliance.
12	<b>Malpractice noticed on MTI Exit Exam</b>	DDG Trg. informed that a show cause notice was issued to IMER Lucknow for malpractice in MTI exit exams and hence suspended till further orders.
13	<b>Matter of M/s. Holy Crescent Maritime College, Kochi</b>	The board approved a 3-month extension for Holy Crescent Maritime College, Kochi, to complete its infrastructure, extending the in-principle approval validity from December 2025 to March 2026.
