ORDER

Reference:

1. Show Cause Notice dated 17.09.2025.

Name of the MTI: M/s. SCMS NADHAL MTI [MTI No. 204075]

Address: Nadhal, Taluka Khalpur, Near Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital Panvel, District Raigad, Maharashtra- 410206.

Whereas, Mercantile Marine Department (MMD) Mumbai vide **letter dated 13.08.2025** had brought to the notice of this Directorate General of Shipping (DGS) that M/s. SCMS NADHAL MTI has been indulging in unauthorized practices including the misuse of the approval granted to the MTI for conduct of DGS approved courses.

Whereas, the matter was deliberated in the 57th STCW Compliance Board meeting and taking into consideration the serious non-compliance of DGS Guidelines, the compliance Board concurred with the recommendation of the Principal Officer, MMD Mumbai and decided that the e-Governance portal of M/s. SCMS NADHAL MTI be blocked with immediate effect, pending further investigation.

Whereas, accordingly, Show Cause Notice dated 17.09.2025 was issued to MTI M/s. SCMS NADHAL MTI.

Whereas, MMD Mumbai vide **letter dated 10.12.2025**, based on the corrective action undertaken by the MTI towards rectification of the deficiencies and assurance to maintain compliance with DGS norms, recommended that the Institute may be allowed to resume all courses, subject to an additional inspection after three months of resumption of operations to verify compliance with DGS guidelines.

The matter was deliberated in the multiple STCW Compliance Board meeting and MMD Mumbai updated the status of compliance taken by MTI. Further, 65th STCW Compliance Board meeting held on 11.12.2025, wherein MMD Mumbai updated that the Institute's apology and declaration to shut down the non-DG approved

courses and comply with DGS regulations. Institute is allowed to resume its two approved courses- **Basic Safety Training and STSDSD** with specified batch limits and an additional condition that an inspection will be conducted three months after resumption.

The recommendation of PO, MMD Mumbai was accepted by the STCW Board.

Further, the Institute vide email dated 10.01.2026 has requested to reduce the approved batches of the M/s. SCMS NADHAL MTI, as given below:
