Maritime Training Trust (MTT) is Public Charitable Trust, registered under Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950. This Trust is settled by the Directorate General of Shipping.

2. Main objectives of the MTT are:
 - i. Providing facilities for adequate training to Indian seafaring officers;
 - ii. Providing all necessary facilities for training and employment of Shore based and Ship Board Officers, to make India a leading supplier of maritime manpower to the world shipping;
 - iii. Encouraging Indian citizens to take to sea and for training Indian seafaring officers, by offering necessary incentives, employment avenues and opportunities – in India or abroad;
 - iv. To institute and award fellowships, scholarships, studentships, medals and prizes in the matter of training Indian Seafaring officers;
3. One of the areas in which MTT has been funding for last 3 years, is sponsoring the Indian Seafaring officer for higher studies at World Maritime University (WMU), Malmo.
4. Every Academic year, WMU conducts Standard MSc. program in following subjects:
 - i. Shipping Management & Logistics
 - ii. Maritime Law & Policy
 - iii. Maritime Safety & Administration
 - iv. Maritime Safety Environment Administration
 - v. Port Management
5. Above courses are residential courses of 11 months durations and held at WMU, Malmo.
6. MTT shall fund the tuition fee, lodging & boarding and other expenses as per norms of WMU. Further, as per WMU norms. one leg of airfare is to be borne by the candidate.
7. The Indian Seafaring officers who want to make career in Merchant Shipping can apply directly to WMU, Malmo to undergo the Standard MSc Program in Maritime Affairs.
8. All interested Indian Seafarers may submit online applications to WMU. Interested persons can visit WMU website (www.wmu.se) and read the Academic Hand Book carefully

before submitting online application directly to WMU. After submitting the application candidate can contact WMU at their mail id msc@wmu.se for further query/assistance.

9. All the applications received by WMU are screened by WMU and short-listed applications are sent by WMU to MTT for final selection by MTT. MTT will select 2 candidates for sponsorship for Academic Year 2026-27 after taking online interview of shortlisted candidates.

10. Applications for academic year 2026-27 are being processed by WMU. Interested candidates may apply to WMU maximum within 10 days from date of this letter.

11. For academic year 2026-27, MTT is desiring to sponsor two Indian Seafaring officer. Preference shall be given to Indian Woman Seafaring Officer.

12. MTT reserves the right of selection of the candidate and decision of MTT shall be final. It can reject application of any candidate without giving reason thereof.

13. This letter is circulated for wide publicity for sponsorship for higher studies in maritime field.
